Tapestry

Thank you to everyone for activating your Tapestry account. It is important that you access this system as it will enable you to see the observations that we have put on about your child and will allow you to share with us what your child has been doing at home. There is an 'About Me' section for you to complete about your child, could you please complete this if you haven't done so already.

Stay and Play Sessions

Please remember to put the dates for our stay and play sessions in your diary. These sessions often prove to be really popular. The children love showing off their friends to members of their family and showing them what they play with at nursery. Our next session will be held on Wednesday 10th December 13:40pm-15:10pm.
