### **Dear Parents/Carers**

Welcome back and Happy New Year to all! We hope that you have all had a lovely relaxing time celebrating Christmas and the New Year.

If your child is due to start school in September this year, please ensure that you apply for your child's reception class place by the national deadline date of **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2026**.

### **Dance Sessions**

We are very excited to announce that we will be holding dance sessions with Louise, the Principal of Newmarket School of Dance again this year. This will take place on a Thursday afternoon for 6 weeks, starting Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> January. The children will get to experience a full dance class from a professional dance teacher. Unfortunately, due to numbers, this opportunity is only open to children who usually attend on a Thursday afternoon.

### **Illness**

If your child is unwell or has a temperature, please do not send them in to nursery. If you have felt the need to give your child Calpol prior to coming to nursery then they are not well enough to be in; please do not send them in to nursery. ### **Stay and Play Session**

Our first stay and play session for 2026 is being held on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> February, 8:40am – 10:10am. We look forward to welcoming in parents/carers for the session.

### **Tapestry**

Remember that you can add to your child's Tapestry, it is nice for us to see what they have been doing at home and gives us an opportunity to talk to them about home life.

### **Clothing**

Please dress your child in layers when attending nursery. It can get chilly inside, as we have the

door open to provide constant access to the outdoor environment for the children. It is easier to take a layer off if they get too hot and put it back on if they get cold.

The weather is very chilly at the moment, so lots of layers and warm waterproof coats and shoes are needed for outdoors.

### **Book of the Fortnight**

We will be introducing our book of the fortnight as soon as we return from the Christmas break. Having a focus on one story really helps the children to get to know the story and having it over two weeks gives all the children this opportunity. During the two weeks staff set up a variety of activities that will link with each story; supporting and developing understanding, increasing vocabulary and encouraging communication.

This half term the stories are as follows:

5<sup>th</sup> January – Stickman

19<sup>th</sup> January – Supertato

2<sup>nd</sup> February – The Three Little Pigs

And after half term we will start with:

23<sup>rd</sup> February – The Gruffalo

### **Pancake Toddle**

On Pancake Day every year we hold a Sponsored 'Pancake Toddle'. As pancake day falls in half term this year, we will hold our toddle on **Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> March at 11.15am**. ### **Mystery Reader**

After February half term we will be introducing our Mystery Reader again. We do this each year once all children have had time to settle into nursery life. The mystery reader volunteers to come in and read a story to the children, this can be a book of your own choice or one that we have here. You don't let your child know that you are coming in and then it's a surprise for all the children. The book can be as short as you would like, or a favourite of your own child's that you would like to share with the other children. This usually takes place during Together Time at the end of either the morning or afternoon session. You are always supported by staff members. If this is something you would like to do, please let Amanda or Vikki know a suitable day or date and we can add you to the list.
